- 13. An unexpected check comes in the mail from a great aunt who has passed away...she left you a \$5,000 inheritance. What do you do with this unexpected windfall?
- 14. You see an ad that details a way to make \$10,000 in 5 days, money back guaranteed. Do you purchase the product or move on?
- 15. Name something you cannot give up. Now, would you give it up for \$50,000?
- 16. There is a knock at your front door, and it's a Girl Scout. You just returned from the grocery store and are fully stocked with cookies, goodies, and all kinds of food. Do you purchase those thin mints? Why or why not?
- 17. Your partner is offered an amazing job opportunity in another city (an airplane ride away) for an awesome \$10,000 extra per year. You have to quit your job to move. Would you do it?
- 18. Given the choice between a satisfying job that pays \$20,000/year with great work/life balance and a 70 hour/weekly job you do not enjoy that pays \$150,000, which would you choose?
- 19. You have a crystal ball (that actually works). What is the financial wish you want fulfilled?
